2022-2023 Competitive Program Details

1. Club dues are all inclusive, **unless otherwise noted**, and helps the Club, among other things, cover costs associated with coaching expenses, club member training clinics, keeper training, field maintenance costs, player and staff insurance, TeamSnap, referee expenses (excluding Summer/Winter league games), winter practice fields, league registration expenses, coaching education advancement, access to the Surf Select program.
2. All teams, except DPL and EA teams, may participate in State Cup.
3. Tournaments: Two—three tournaments are included in your Club Dues for all teams **except** DPL and EA teams. DPL and EA teams should instead expect an additional eight—fourteen games of DPL/EA league play, and one to two college show case events.
4. A \$150 volunteer fee per player is collected during registration. This fee will be refunded if you complete five hours of volunteer service per player and the registered player participates for the entire 2022-2023 season. Eligible volunteer service includes work at cleanup days, working the concession stand, field lining, and other opportunities as approved by the Board of Directors. If you do not volunteer, this money is used to pay (i.e. contractors) to carry out the necessary work.
5. The uniform package must be ordered through Soccer.com. Due to ongoing challenges faced by Nike and Soccer.com we **strongly** encourage you to order your uniform package as soon as the store opens. The online store is expected to open June 1st. Samples are available for you to check for sizing prior to ordering. The uniform cost has not been finalized yet by Soccer.com and may differ from what is currently listed.
6. Players may incur other costs that are specific to their individual team, or the individual member, and are not covered by Club Dues. They could/will include: Team Equipment, personal cost of travel, extra tournaments, Summer/Winter NorCal league, and other team specific discretionary costs, team field rentals, coach's overnight travel expenses etc.
7. All teams participate in two league seasons (Fall 2022 and Spring 2023). These are included in your Club Dues.
8. U15 through U19 teams may take the high school soccer season off. U15 through U19 players who are not participating in high school soccer during the winter break can participate in free club training sessions that will be offered by the club during this time period.
9. All players pay June 2022 through March 2023 (10 Months). The competitive year is 12 Months (June 2022 through May 2023), of which 9 or 10 months, depending on the team, are active with 8 to 12 weeks of downtime, depending on the team is required to be taken off. Generally the off time is taken during the high school or winter season for most teams. Fees are not waived if you leave the club of your own volition prior to the end of the competitive year. *Additionally, the monthly dues are not tied to whether or not the team is on break or is actively training.*
10. As a nonprofit organization our Club dues are set as close as possible to our actual costs, which means we rely on all players paying the dues they have committed to in a timely manner. As such, refunds are not available under any circumstances. This includes but is not limited to natural disasters, emergency government actions impacting operations, pandemics, etc.
11. Soccer is an outdoor activity that can be impacted by inclement weather. Heavy rains can and do close the fields. We will cancel or alter games and training sessions were there is a risk to player safety. There are no refunds if games or trainings are canceled as a result of inclement weather, including rain, smoke, or heat.
