## Solano Surf Soccer Club 2023-2024 Competitive Program Details

1. Club dues are all inclusive, **unless otherwise noted**, and helps the Club, among other things, cover costs associated with coaching expenses, club member training clinics, keeper training, field maintenance costs, player and staff insurance, Byga, referee expenses (excluding Summer/Winter league games), winter practice fields, league registration expenses, coaching education advancement, access to the Surf Select program.
2. Three payment plans are available this year through the Byga platform: Pay in full, pay monthly for six months, or pay monthly for ten months. Payments made through Byga will also incur a processing fee per payment. If you wish to pay in full via check you will not have to pay the Byga processing fee. Please contact [registrar@solanosurf.org](mailto:registrar@solanosurf.org) to make arrangements prior to registering your player.
3. This year we will be conducting a mandatory raffle fundraiser. All players will be expected to sell 15 raffle tickets which cost \$10 per ticket.
4. State Cup is included in the registration fees for all teams except U8, DPL, and EA teams.
5. Tournaments: Two—three tournaments are included in your Club Dues for all teams **except** DPL and EA teams. DPL and EA teams should instead expect an additional eight—fourteen games of DPL/EA league play, and one to two college show case events.
6. A \$150 volunteer fee per player is collected during registration. This fee will be refunded if you complete five hours of volunteer service per player and the registered player participates for the entire 2023-2024 season. Eligible volunteer service includes work at cleanup days, working the concession stand, and other opportunities as approved by the Board of Directors.
7. The uniform package must be ordered through Soccer Post. We **strongly** encourage you to order your uniform package as soon as the store opens. The online store is expected to open in June. The uniform cost has not been finalized yet by Soccer Post and may differ from what is currently listed.
8. Players may incur other costs that are specific to their individual team, or the individual member, and are not covered by Club Dues. This could include: Team Equipment, personal cost of travel, extra tournaments, Summer/Winter NorCal league, and other team specific discretionary costs, team field rentals, coach's travel expenses etc.
9. All teams participate in two league seasons (Fall 2023 and Spring 2024). These are included in your Club Dues.
10. U15 through U19 teams typically take the high school soccer season off. Payments are still due during this break if you have selected the payment plan.
11. The competitive year is 12 Months (June 2023 through May 2024), of which 9 or 10 months, depending on the team, are active with 8 to 12 weeks of downtime, depending on the team is required to be taken off. Generally the off time is taken during the high school or winter season for most teams. In general fees are not waived if you leave the club prior to the end of the competitive year. *Additionally, the monthly payments are not tied to whether or not the team is on break or is actively training.*
12. As a nonprofit organization our Club dues are set as close as possible to our actual costs, which means we rely on all players paying the dues they have committed to in a timely manner.
13. Soccer is an outdoor activity that can be impacted by inclement weather. Heavy rains can and do close the fields. We will cancel or alter games and training sessions were there is a risk to player safety. There are no refunds if games or trainings are canceled as a result of inclement weather, including rain, smoke, or heat.
